- Action Plan Implementation Activity
 - Pharmacists' Patient Care Process
 - HOPA representative John Valgus is participating in this initiative.
 - Pharmacy Quality
 - A task force is beginning implementation of the "Big Idea" proposal that focuses on minimal competencies for the non-specialist in cancer care
 - Work continues on the Entry-level Competencies for new PharmD graduates and PGY1 residents in oncology
 - Value of Pharmacists' Patient Care Services
 - HOPA established a task force on Value of the Heme/Onc Pharmacist with goal to establish metrics of value in the Oncology Care Model. Starting in 2018, this task force will be elevated to a Committee due to the importance of their on-going work.
 - HOPA task force on Scope of Hematology/Oncology Pharmacy services "part 2" met in May. The document is expected to be completed by December 2017.
 - HOPA has established two task forces relating to oral chemotherapy. One is the Oral Chemotherapy Patient Education Handout Task Force, focused on the creation of patient education materials in collaboration with NCODA, ACCC and ONS. The other is the Oral Chemotherapy Standards Task Force, focused on role of the heme/onc pharmacist in oral chemotherapy patient management
 - Participated in the *Frankly Speaking About Cancer* (Cancer Support Community's radio show airing on the Voice of America Health and

Wellness Channel) on 3/3/2017 to convey the value of services provided by heme/onc pharmacists to a patient audience

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- Provider Status Recognition
 - Provider Status/PAPCC
 - Held a session at the HOPA annual meeting on March 29, 2017 reviewing the legislation and ways members can advocate for provider status
 - On May 16, 2017, 14 HOPA members from 9 states visited more than 50 Congressional offices to seek co-sponsorship of H.R. 592 and S. 109
- Organization Update (other information):
 - HOPA 13th Annual Conference Anaheim, CA March 29-April 1
 - The Drug Waste Summit was held on May 8, 2017 in Washington, DC
 - HOPA has become a member of ASCO CancerLinQ and is a founding member of their Oncology Leadership Council
 - HOPA and American Society of Health System Pharmacists (ASHP) have partnered on the “Role of the Pharmacy Technician” which is expected to be published in the *American Journal of Health-System Pharmacy*.
 - “Dose Rounding of Cytotoxic Drugs and Monoclonal Antibodies” Position Paper has been completed.
 - Launched a nationwide program on patient/ HCP tool kit focused on CINV with Eisai and Helsinn
 - Projects in development:
 - Patient Pharmacist Partnership Educational Materials
