Dr. Lynette Bradley-Baker is the Senior Vice President of Public Affairs and Engagement at the American Association of Colleges of Pharmacy (AACP). She has been on staff at AACP since August 2010 and has held the positions of Director of Professional Alliance Development and Vice President of Public Affairs and Engagement.

Dr. Bradley-Baker graduated from the University of Maryland School of Pharmacy with a Bachelor of Science in Pharmacy and from the University of Maryland, Baltimore Graduate School with a Doctor of Philosophy, with an emphasis on patient education/information services.
