  - CPNP has been active in distributing comment letters on MH and SUD funding, legislation, and regulation, scope of practice, and telehealth regulation and legislation:

  - CPNP hosted over 1,000 at its virtual Annual Meeting, April 19-23 and featured over 210 posters presented over 2 poster sessions, nearly 30 hours of programming, watch parties, and numerous networking opportunities.
  - DEI: CPNP has placed a significant priority on DEI within its strategic plan which will be finalized by the CPNP Board in May. Immediate actions will involve the formation of a committee to identify priorities, selection of a consultant, and appointment of a liaison to the board during the period when the DEI committee formulates its recommendations. CPNP also has a newly formed DEI community whose focus is fostering DEI in patient care and access.
